Central Park

6450 Route 31, Cicero



In addition to a pavilion, the park has multiple baseball fields, and a community playground. The park encompasses 25 acres and provides endless opportunities for active recreation. Central Park is the official home of the Cicero Little League and the Cicero Falcons Football and Cheer teams. * We do not offer outside rentals at this park.

Gateway Park

7900 St. Francis Dr, Bridgeport



Nestled in a neighborhood, Gateway Park features a handicap-accessible 1/4 mile walking trail. Children enjoy playing on the two playgrounds, including one built specifically for preschool-age children. As one of the largest Town parks (39 acres), the ball fields, basketball courts and wide open space can be used for a multitude of recreational activities. Gateway is home of the Salt City Snipers Lacrosse.

Plank Road Park

5471 Mudmill Rd, Brewerton



This is the Town of Cicero's largest park at 43 acres! In the park, visitors can enjoy a stroll on our 3/4 mile trail through a natural wooded setting, play on our playground, sit under one of our pavilions or enjoy our sand volleyball courts. This park also has several soccer fields and is home to the Cicero Youth Soccer League. (New parking lot enhancements as of 2023!)

Sheldon Park

8011 Route 31, Bridgeport



Named after Bridgeport Fire Department's First Chief, Harry Sheldon, this often-forgotten park is located on the banks of Chittenango Creek. Because the park is located on Route 31, it is NYS Bike Route #5 rest stop for cyclists passing through the area. For everyone else, it is a park that offers shade under the pavilion, a chance to relax or a great spot to do some stream fishing.

Skyway Park

5950 E Taft Rd, N Syracuse



This park is located near Interstate 81. Visitors can shoot hoops, use the playground, play tennis or pickleball, as well as utilize the ball fields or enjoy the LARGEST of our pavilions for a picnic! It is also the home of the North Syracuse Little League.

Joseph F William Memorial Park & Beach

7033 Lakeshore Rd, Cicero



As one of the most popular Town parks, Joseph F. William Memorial Park offers opportunities for both land and water activities. Three Eagle Scout-constructed pavilions are available to rent while the gazebo is a popular setting for small weddings or formal pictures. During the summer months, our park is packed with families enjoying picnics, grilling, shuffleboard, summer concerts and the beautiful sunsets that Oneida Lake has to offer. Water enthusiasts launch their canoes and kayaks, while fishermen enjoy the floating dock for casting a line. We do allow wading in a small roped in area. **(New construction of our playground and splashpad beginning this Spring 2023!!)** During the busy season, additional parking is available across the street.
